From the President...

Fellow Members

A reminder to members that the club's Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held on Wednesday 28th October, 2009 at 7.30pm. The 2009 Annual Reports will be distributed to members in early October. If members have any questions relating to the Annual Report they should be sent to John Stevenson prior to the AGM. Playing Members eligible to vote at an AGM are encouraged to attend.

**The Course**

The Board at its last meeting approved the capital expenditure of \$30,000 for a new pump system for the dam on the club's south land (former Mirvac land). This pumping system will be connected to our existing irrigation pipe line and will significantly add to our existing water capacity, which will be appreciated during the summer months. It is envisaged that the capital works will be completed in early December.

Following the recent renovations the standard of the greens are improving. As we get 2 closer to our Club championships the greens will be rolled and double cut, further improving the putting surface and the

speed. Playing members should be aware that we are still experiencing tree root encroachment on the perimeter of some greens. With the dryer weather this will exacerbate. Over the coming months the greens staff will be continuing to address the problem but it is a significant issue that will take time to resolve.

**Our Trading**

The Club's trading during the first two months of the new financial year (July and August) has been very strong. In July and August period the Club made a slight profit. Traditionally July and August are our worst trading months and to make even a small profit is a great start. Obviously the work done on the Clubhouse, La Bocca Restaurant, the New Brighton Room and our Club promotions is having a very positive impact.

In terms of the Course, our revenue for the first two months is down by about 5%. This is mainly due to the Course being closed for 5 days during July, along with a total of 9 very wet days. In August however our course revenue was up 9% on last year. So the start of the year is a great

improvement and all indications are that 2010 will be a positive year.

**Being a Mate**

Responsible service of alcohol is a real issue for the Club. There are heavy fines for staff and the Club if we are found to be serving intoxicated patrons. We have had some occasions where members continue to supply drink to patrons that have been cut-off at the Bar. People may see this as being a mate, but it can have severe ramifications for the Club, the individual and the member providing the booze.

So to be a real mate, look after your mate. If they seem to be having too many you might suggest enough is enough, suggest they take the bus home or get them a cab. But most off all don't continue to supply them with more drinks.


