Responsible Service of Alcohol [RSA]

Children under the age of 18 are welcome at New Brighton Golf Club as long as they are sitting with their parents whilst in the Restaurant or designated area within the Main Bar area. Children are not permitted to walk or run throughout the Club without the presence of their parents or to be within three [3] metres of any Bar. Children are permitted to use the Children's Room and external Playground area but are to do so and remain in the care of their Parents.

Did you know that if the Licensing Police attend the Club and find a child un-attended, the Parent responsible for the care of the child is liable to a Fine of \$330. Staff are liable to a Fine of \$550 and Management a Fine of \$1,100.

Due to the bi-annual [1st February & 1st August] increase of brewery prices, the Club will have to raise bar prices as of Friday, 7 August 2009 in accordance with the Government's CPI-linked excise and customs increase, the Breweries increase of production cost of products. From the President...

Fellow Members

In this months newsletter I would like to let members know about the upcoming General Meeting where members will be asked to consider a resolution to allow the Club to submit a Rezoning Application to Liverpool City Council. The resolution also seeks approval from members as part of the Rezoning to transfer Club land to Liverpool Council along with the transfer of land from Liverpool Council to New Brighton Golf Club.

To ensure the Club met its legal obligations under the Corporations Act, Registered Clubs Act, and the Club's Articles, we asked our legal advisers, Thompson Playford Cutlers, to draft the resolutions and advise on any relevant matters. During the initial drafting and review of the Registered Clubs Act our lawyers first advised the Club that the resolution needed to be voted on by all members, including Social Members, as the

resolution involved the transfer of core land.

On further investigation our lawyers have now advised that the regulations provide specific exemptions where the transfer of land is to a government body ie Liverpool City Council. Thus the General Meeting on Wednesday 26th August at 7.30pm will only involve playing members as per the Club's Articles (see Article 5.1 (a))

As members would be aware the Club's Articles only allows for financial Playing Members to attend and vote at a General Meeting.

At the General Meeting members will consider two resolutions. The first is a special resolution to change in the Article of Association regarding eligibility of members to vote on the election of Directors (see Article 5.1 (c) (ii)). Essentially changing

the proportion of Social Members to Playing Members to less than 25%, where it currently stands at 50%

The second resolution is a General Resolution to enable the Club to submit a Rezoning Application to Liverpool Council, including the transfer of 'core' land and the expenditure of \$250,000 to provide the supporting reports to the rezoning application. Notices regarding the General Meeting have been sent to members.

The General Meeting will be pivotal in the Club's future and we encourage you to attend and vote.

That's it for July '09, enjoy your golf and the Club facilities.

Following questions from some members I would like to provide some background information on course measurement. At present course metreage is measured from a permanent distance marker which is painted yellow and situated near the back of the tee. The blue plates define the area from which championship events are played and are movable. The ladies measurement is taken from the red plate area. Further to this Golf

Australia is planning to adopt the USGA course rating system that may result in two or more separate course ratings subject to tee marker placement for each event.
